3 Dental Association's Council on Governmental Affairs,
4 demonstrating visionary leadership skills and remarkable

21 International College of Dentists and has been named a Paul Harris
22 Fellow by Rotary International; and

23 WHEREAS, John S. Findley is an outstanding doctor as well as a
24 natural leader who has demonstrated a willingness to accept and

1 meet challenges; his colleagues are fortunate to have him as their
2 advocate, and it is a privilege to pay tribute to him at this time;
3 now, therefore, be it
