14 Denver, Colorado, Mr. Lorfing served as manager of the lands and  
15 minerals department, until his retirement in 1978; and

17 through his many civic endeavors; this generous individual served  
18 as a volunteer with the VA chaplain service and the American Heart  
19 Association and was a 10-year Republican party chairman; moreover,  
20 he was a valued congregant of Zion Lutheran Church and worked with  
21 the students of Starkey Elementary School as a mentor; and

23 Mr. Lorfing will long miss his presence, and he will be remembered
