6 Prairie View A&M University, from which she attained her master's
7 degree, Ms. Jackson embarked on a career as an educator that spanned
8 41 years, during which time she was a teacher and band director in
9 Gladewater, a choir and band director in Wichita Falls, and an
10 elementary workshop teacher in Sierra Leone, Africa; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson maintained affiliations with many
12 professional organizations, including the Texas State Teachers
13 Association, the Retired Teachers Association, the Association of
14 Music Teachers, Partners in Education, and the Booker T. Washington
15 Alumni Association; in addition, she participated in a variety of
16 worthy community organizations and was a member of Antioch Baptist
17 Church, where she served the congregation as deaconess, musician,
18 as publicity chairperson, and as a member of WMU; and

19 WHEREAS, A person whose life is a continuing inspiration to
20 her family and friends, as well as her former coworkers and
21 students, Ms. Jackson is a shining example of the ability of one
22 person to make a difference in the lives of many, and her work
23 during her time on this earth will continue to enrich all those who
24 were fortunate enough to know her; now, therefore, be it
