1 WHEREAS, Susan Elizabeth Skaggs of Irving, director of civic
2 affairs, Dallas Cowboys Football Club, and Special Events Director,
3 Texas Stadium Corporation, is a dedicated leader who has long
4 played an active role in making her community a better place to
5 live, work, and raise a family; and

6 WHEREAS, Involved with the marketing of Texas Stadium events
7 and tours, Ms. Skaggs has helped to promote this venerable venue
8 that brings more than \$400 million to the city of Irving each year;
9 she has helped to develop and implement important corporate
10 citizenship programs for the Dallas Cowboys, one of which received
11 an Irving Academy of Community Service Award while under her
12 guidance; and

13 WHEREAS, The efforts of Ms. Skaggs extend to a number of
14 charitable groups in the community, including the Salvation Army,
15 where she has served as a member of the advisory board and on the
16 fund-raising committee, the nominating committee, and the child
17 development committee; she especially enjoys the organization's
18 annual Super Lunch, a Christmas luncheon for 500 underwritten by
19 the Dallas Cowboys and hosted by the Gene and Jerry Jones family
20 that has raised more than \$1.3 million to date; and

21 WHEREAS, This notable Texan also serves on the board of
22 directors for the Irving Family Advocacy Center, the Irving
23 Symphony Orchestra Association, and the Dallas/Fort Worth Area
24 Tourism Council; an active member of the Junior League since 1990,

1 she has organized projects related to health issues through
2 Parkland Hospital and the Children's Medical Center of Dallas, and
3 has served as project chairman for Social Services with Irving
4 C.A.R.E.S.; and

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Skaggs is a tireless force in the area of
6 community service and has consistently placed a priority on the
7 needs of her fellow citizens; a true friend to the Irving community,
8 she is indeed deserving of special recognition; now, therefore, be
9 it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
11 Legislature hereby commend Susan Elizabeth Skaggs for her
12 outstanding service to the city of Irving and extend to her sincere
13 best wishes for continued success; and, be it further
