WHEREAS, In 1934, after having received his law degree, he settled in Corpus Christi where he practiced law for more than 60 years; he was a member of the Texas Supreme Court Advisory Committee on Rules of Civil Procedure from 1949 to 1986, the Board of Directors of the Nueces River Authority from 1972 to 1988, and the American College of Trial Lawyers; and

WHEREAS, Appointed judge of the 94th District Court of Nueces County by Governor W. Lee "Pappy" O'Daniel in 1941 and subsequently by Governor Coke Stevenson, this patriotic American also served his country as a lieutenant commander in the U.S. Navy during World War II; and

WHEREAS, Judge Wood was a member of numerous civic and professional organizations; he was a mentor to two generations of South Texas lawyers and was honored in 1983 with the Corpus Christi Bar Association's Cecil E. Burney Humanitarian Award; and

WHEREAS, A man of compassion, humor, and literary talent, he authored seven unpublished volumes of poetry, including *Life on a*
