R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Honorable James R. "Rick" Stacy recently
2 concluded a distinguished seven-year tenure as mayor of the City of
3 Southlake, and his dedication to serving his fellow citizens as a
4 public official is truly worthy of special recognition; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in Dallas on December 29, 1947, Mr. Stacy is a
6 1966 graduate of Grapevine High School; he completed his college
7 degree at the University of North Texas, where he majored in
8 industrial management, before embarking on a remarkable career in
9 business in the field of home furnishings; over the past 12 years he
10 has transformed his family's once-struggling furniture company
11 into a highly successful enterprise, one that has been honored by
12 Baylor University as an "Outstanding Small Business" and one that
13 today boasts a beautiful 250,000-square-foot flagship store; and

14 WHEREAS, This civic-minded individual, who became mayor of
15 Southlake in 1996, was an esteemed member of the local city council
16 for two years and, additionally, served on the Southlake Parks
17 Development Corporation from 1996 to 2003; over the course of his
18 career in public service, he helped to significantly reduce the
19 city's debt costs and was instrumental in bringing two major
20 corporations, Sabre National Headquarters and the Verizon Wireless
21 Control Center, to the city of Southlake; and

23 Tarrant County charities and organizations, including the Lions
24 Club, the Southlake CARS Program, the Muscular Dystrophy

4 his cherished wife, Diane, and together the couple have lovingly
5 built a happy homelife for their four children, Dorian, Elizabeth,
6 Ashley, and Jay, all of whom can take immense pride in their
7 father's many exemplary achievements as an elected official, a
8 businessman, and a community leader; now, therefore, be it
