15 including the Association of Texas Professional Educators, the  
16 American Counseling Association, the Texas Counseling Association,  
17 and the Texas School Counseling Association, Mrs. Cunningham has

20           WHEREAS, She is a recipient of the Heart of Texas Counseling  
21 Association's 2003 Outstanding High School Counselor Award and the  
22 CISD school board's 2001 Recognition Award; she was also honored in  
23 1994 as the Heart of Texas Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse
