RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 2 Texas, 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, 3 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 5 resolve the differences on House Bill 3622, relating to the creation, administration, powers, duties, operation, and financing 6 of the Kingsborough Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Kaufman 7 County, to consider and take action on the following matter: 8

9 House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (3) are suspended to 10 permit the committee to amend Section 15(a) of the bill to read as 11 follows:

(a) This Act takes effect on the date on or after September 12 1, 2003, on which a settlement agreement between the City of 13 14 Crandall and the developer of the districts is legally executed regarding a pending petition before the Texas Commission on 15 Environmental Quality for the right to provide retail water service 16 to certain areas within the districts. If the settlement agreement 17 is legally executed before September 1, 2003, this Act takes effect 18 19 September 1, 2003.

Explanation: This change is necessary to ensure that the bill takes effect on a more appropriate date.
