10 time for Texans to set aside the cares of daily life and enjoy the  
11 bounty of a successful harvest season; a tribute to the  
12 agricultural heritage of Cherokee County, this wonderful event is

16 Legislature hereby recognize the Jacksonville Tomato Festival, to
