1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to pay
2 tribute to Dr. Peggy B. Smith for her exceptional professional
3 accomplishments; and

4 WHEREAS, Director of the Baylor Teen Clinic in Houston, Dr.
5 Smith oversees reproductive health services for indigent teens and
6 has published more than 95 articles and three books on related
7 topics; she chairs the Greater Houston Collaborative for Children
8 and the statewide Family Planning Advisory Committee for the
9 commissioner of the Texas Department of Health; and

10 WHEREAS, She was appointed by Governors White, Clements,
11 Richards, and Bush to chair the Children's Trust Fund of Texas,
12 served on Governor Richards's State-wide Health Task Force, and was
13 appointed by the speaker of the Texas House of Representatives to
14 serve on the Select Committee on Adolescent Pregnancy; on a wider
15 scale, she has also served as a member of the National Advisory
16 Council of the Hogg Foundation; and

17 WHEREAS, An alumna of The University of Texas, this esteemed
18 Texan earned bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees by the age
19 of 23 and was voted Sweetheart of The University of Texas and Queen
20 of the Cotton Bowl; Dr. Smith has received a Kezia DePelchin Award
21 and a 1996 Good Samaritan Award for her work in behalf of health
22 care and child abuse prevention, and she has also been an American
23 Leadership Forum fellow; and

24 WHEREAS, Throughout her life, Dr. Smith has set high
