## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 2 Texas, 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, 3 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 1952, relating to the 5 reorganization of, efficiency in, and other reform measures 6 7 applying to state government, to consider and take action on the 8 following matter:

9 (1) House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(3) and (4), are suspended 10 to permit the committee to add new text to Section 521.142(a), 11 Transportation Code, so that the subsection reads as follows:

An application for an original license must state the 12 (a) applicant's full name and place and date of birth. This information 13 14 must be verified by presentation of proof of identity satisfactory The department shall accept as proof of the 15 to the department. applicant's identity an identity document that is issued by the 16 government of another country, if that document bears 17 the applicant's photograph, full name, and date of birth and the 18 19 government of the other country has established reasonable mechanisms by which the department can verify the identity 20 21 document. For purposes of this section, an identity document includes a passport, a consular identity document, and a national 22 identity document. On the reverse side of a driver's license, the 23 24 department shall print the license holder's country of citizenship 25 and indicate the country of citizenship by a uniform symbol or code

2	indicates a restriction or endorsement.
