

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, That House Rule 13,
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on House Bill 727, relating to disease
6 management programs for certain Medicaid recipients, to consider
7 and take action on the following matter:

8 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the
9 committee to add text to Section 32.059(e), Human Resources Code,
10 to read as follows:

11 (e) The department may enter into a contract under this
12 section with a comprehensive hemophilia diagnostic treatment
13 center that receives funding through a maternal and child health
14 services block grant under Section 501(a)(2), Social Security Act
15 (42 U.S.C. Section 701), and the center shall be considered a
16 disease management provider.

17 Explanation: The added text is necessary to ensure that a
18 comprehensive hemophilia diagnostic treatment center is considered
19 a disease management provider.
