## Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, S.B. No. 86

## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of Texas, 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on Senate Bill 86, relating to admissions to public institutions of higher education, to consider and take

House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the conference committee to include the following text amending Section 28.026, Education Code, in the bill:

NOTICE OF AUTOMATIC COLLEGE ADMISSION. <u>(</u>a) 11 The board of trustees of a school district shall require each high 12 school in the district to post appropriate signs 13 14 counselor's office, in each principal's office, and administrative building indicating the substance of Section 51.803 15 regarding automatic college admission. То assist in 16 the dissemination of this information, the school district shall: 17
- (1) require that each high school counselor and class
  advisor be provided a detailed explanation of the substance of

- information about the changes in law made by the bill is publicized
