Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, H.B. No. 2455 (Chisum/Nelson)

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## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 Texas, 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, That House Rule 13, 2 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 5 resolve the differences on House Bill 2455, relating to the governmental entities subject to, and the confidentiality of 6 7 records under, the sunset review process, to consider and take 8 action on the following matter:

9 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the 10 committee to add new sections to the bill to read as follows:

SECTION 1.03. TEXAS LOTTERY COMMISSION AND LOTTERY
DIVISION. (a) Section 467.002, Government Code, is amended to read
as follows:

Sec. 467.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The commission is 14 subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in 15 existence as provided by that chapter, the commission is abolished 16 and this Act expires September 1, 2005 [2003]. In the review of the 17 commission by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this 18 19 section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset commission to 20 the 78th Legislature. In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report 21 to the 79the Legislature, the sunset commission may include any 22 recommendations it considers appropriate. 23

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(b) Section 466.003(a), Government Code, is amended to read

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1 as follows:

(a) The lottery division is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas 2 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that 3 chapter, the division is abolished and this chapter expires 4 5 September 1, 2005 [2003]. In the review of the lottery division by 6 the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this section, the 7 sunset commission shall limit its review to the appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset commission to the 78th 8 Legislature. In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report to the 9 79the Legislature, the sunset commission may include any 10 recommendations it considers appropriate. 11

(c) This section takes effect only if the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, does not enact other legislation that becomes law and that amends Section 467.002, Government Code, to extend the sunset date of the Texas Lottery Commission. If the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.

SECTION 1.04. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS. (a) Section 2306.022, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2306.022. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. 21 The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs is subject to Chapter 22 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided 23 24 by that chapter, the department is abolished and this chapter 25 expires September 1, 2005 [2003]. In the review of the department 26 by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the appropriateness of 27

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1 recommendations made by the sunset commission to the 78th 2 Legislature and the extent to which the department has implemented 3 laws enacted by the 77th Legislature in continuing the department. 4 In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report to the 79th Legislature, 5 the sunset commission may include any recommendations it considers 6 appropriate.

7 (b) This section takes effect only if the 78th Legislature, 8 Regular Session, 2003, does not enact other legislation that 9 becomes law and that amends Section 2306.022, Government Code, to 10 extend the sunset date of the Texas Department of Housing and 11 Community Affairs. If the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, 12 enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.

SECTION 1.05. TEXAS AFFORDABLE HOUSING CORPORATION. (a)
 Section 2306.5521, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

15 Sec. 2306.5521. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas 16 17 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the corporation is abolished and this subchapter expires 18 19 September 1, 2005 [2003]. In the review of the corporation by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this section, the sunset 20 21 commission shall limit its review to the appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset commission to the 78th 22 Legislature. In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report to the 23 79th Legislature, the sunset commission may include 24 any recommendations it considers appropriate. 25

(b) This section takes effect only if the 78th Legislature,
27 Regular Session, 2003, does not enact other legislation that

becomes law and that amends Section 2306.5521, Government Code, to extend the sunset date of the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation. If the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.

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SECTION 1.06. TEXAS HIGHER EDUCATION COORDINATING BOARD. 5 6 (a) Section 61.0211, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 61.0211. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Higher Education 7 8 Coordinating Board is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code 9 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and this chapter expires 10 September 1, 2005 [2003]. In the review of the board by the sunset 11 12 commission, as required by this section, the commission shall limit its review to the appropriateness of recommendations made by the 13 commission to the 78th Legislature. In the commissions report to 14 15 the 79th Legislature, the commission may include any recommendations it considers appropriate. 16

(b) This section only takes effect if the 78th Legislature. Regular Session, 2003, does not enact other legislation that becomes law and that amends Section 61.0211, education Code, to extend the sunset date of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. If the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect.

23 SECTION 2.06. REGIONAL EDUCATION SERVICE CENTERS. If the 24 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, enacts legislation that 25 becomes law and that makes regional education service centers 26 subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), the 27 comptroller of public accounts shall assist the Sunset Advisory

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Commission in its review. The comptroller shall conduct a review of 1 2 the regional education service centers and report the results of 3 the review to the Sunset Advisory Commission before March 1, 2004. 4 The comptroller shall consult the Sunset Advisory Commission regarding the scope of the review. The report shall also be 5 6 transmitted to the presiding officers of the standing committee in the senate and the house of representatives responsible for public 7 8 education.

9 Explanation: These additions are needed to ensure that the 10 Texas Lottery Commission, the lottery division, the Texas 11 Department of Housing and Community Affairs, the Texas Affordable 12 Housing Corporation, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating 13 Board, and regional education service centers are continued in 14 existence but are reviewed without unnecessary delay by the Sunset 15 Advisory Commission.
