RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Americans are living longer and healthier lives, and 2 between 2000 and 2040 the nation's senior population is expected to

3 increase by 193 percent; and

WHEREAS, While more than 2.7 million Texans, representing almost 10 percent of the state's population, are presently age 60 or older, it is projected that seniors will number 8.1 million, or 23

7 percent of the Lone Star State's populace, by 2040; and

8 WHEREAS, Currently, over 1.4 million Texas seniors are 9 licensed drivers, a number that is expected to grow significantly 10 in the future, and it is important that members of this age 11 demographic maintain active, independent lifestyles as long as 12 possible; and

WHEREAS, It provides a social and economic benefit to Texas for seniors to continue driving as long as they can do so safely; moreover, safe mobility, including driving and walking, as well as alternative forms of convenient and reliable transportation, is essential for a satisfactory quality of life for seniors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas Legislature hereby recognize June 2003 as Texas Senior Mobility Awareness Month.
