5 WHEREAS, Born August 11, 1925, in Starr County, Mr. Escobar 6 entered the United States Navy in 1943 and retired from military 7 service in September 1969; he served in World War II, the Korean 8 War, and the Vietnam War aboard several carriers, including the USS 9 *Yorktown*, USS *Oriskany*, and the USS *Enterprise*; and
