R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, A great city is not judged by its size, power, or
2 wealth, but by the kind of man it chooses as its leader; and

3 WHEREAS, The three-time All-America City of Edinburg has
4 bestowed the honor and responsibility of leadership on Ricardo
5 Rodriguez, Jr., elected in the spring of 2002 as city council member
6 by an informed and active constituency; and

7 WHEREAS, Councilman Rodriguez brings with him the strength of
8 character forged by a lifetime of achievements and lessons learned,
9 and in his new post he will continue building on Edinburg's
10 reputation as a regional leader in our beloved state; and

11 WHEREAS, This dedicated public servant puts a high priority
12 in the real objective of education, which is to give children
13 resources that will endure as long as life endures; habits that time
14 will ameliorate, not destroy; occupations that will render sickness
15 tolerable, solitude pleasant, age venerable, and life more
16 dignified and useful; and

17 WHEREAS, Councilman Rodriguez's vision of leadership is
18 based on the belief that the best government is one that teaches us
19 to govern ourselves, and he is and will be a key figure in the
20 economic and educational advances that will propel Edinburg into

9 Council, Ricardo Rodriguez, Jr., will set a high standard of
10 leadership based on his noble goal of being truly esteemed by his
11 fellow citizens by rendering himself worthy of their esteem; now,
12 therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
14 Legislature hereby commend Ricardo Rodriguez, Jr., for his past and
15 future service in behalf of Edinburg, the three-time All-America
16 City; and, be it further
