4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 623, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter L to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER L. VICTORIA COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT PERMITS
8	Sec. 623.230. OPTIONAL PROCEDURE. This subchapter provides
9	an optional procedure for the issuance of a permit by the Victoria
10	County Navigation District for the movement of oversize or
11	overweight vehicles carrying cargo on state highways located in
12	<u>Victoria County.</u>
13	Sec. 623.231. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "district"
14	means the Victoria County Navigation District.
15	Sec. 623.232. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS. The Texas
16	Transportation Commission may authorize the district to issue
17	permits for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles
18	carrying cargo on state highways located in Victoria County.
19	Sec. 623.233. MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS. The district shall
20	make payments to the department to provide funds for the
21	maintenance of state highways subject to this subchapter.
22	Sec. 623.234. PERMIT FEES. (a) The district may collect a
23	fee for permits issued under this subchapter. The fees shall not
24	exceed \$80 per trip.

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1	(b) Fees collected under Subsection (a) shall be used solely
2	to provide funds for the payments provided for under Section
3	623.233 less administrative costs, which shall not exceed 15
4	percent of the fees collected. The fees shall be deposited in the
5	state highway fund. Fees deposited in the state highway fund under
6	this section are exempt from the application of Section 403.095,
7	Government Code.
8	Sec. 623.235. PERMIT REQUIREMENTS. (a) A permit issued
9	under this subchapter must include:
10	(1) the name of the applicant;
11	(2) the date of issuance;
12	(3) the signature of the director of the district;
13	(4) a statement of the kind of cargo being transported
14	over Farm-to-Market Road 1432 to and from the Victoria Barge Canal
15	and up to but not past the intersection with State Highway 185, the
16	maximum weight and dimensions of the equipment, and the kind and
17	weight of each commodity to be transported, provided that the gross
18	weight of such equipment and commodities shall not exceed 125,000
19	pounds;
20	(5) a statement of any condition on which the permit is
21	issued;
22	(6) a statement that the cargo shall only be
23	transported to and from the Victoria Barge Canal using
24	Farm-to-Market Road 1432 and may not be transported over State
25	Highway 185;
26	(7) the name of the driver of the vehicle in which the
27	cargo is to be transported; and

1	(8) the location where the cargo was loaded.
2	(b) The district shall report to the department all permits
3	issued under this subchapter.
4	Sec. 623.236. TIME OF MOVEMENT. A permit issued under this
5	subchapter shall specify the time in which movement authorized by
6	the permit is allowed.
7	Sec. 623.237. SPEED LIMIT. Movement authorized by a permit
8	issued under this subchapter shall not exceed the posted speed
9	limit or 55 miles per hour, whichever is less. Violation of this
10	provision shall constitute a moving violation.
11	Sec. 623.238. ENFORCEMENT. The Department of Public Safety
12	shall have authority to enforce the provisions of this subchapter.
13	Sec. 623.239. RULES. The Texas Transportation Commission
14	may adopt rules necessary to implement this subchapter.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
