S.B. No. 21

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the designation of the parts of Interstate Highway 10  
3 and Interstate Highway 35 between Houston and Belton as Heroes  
4 Highway.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
7 is amended by adding Section 225.0225 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 225.0225. HEROES HIGHWAY. (a) To honor all civilians  
9 and military personnel who have served the United States in times of  
10 war, Interstate Highway 10 between Uvalde Road in Houston and its  
11 intersection with Interstate Highway 35 in San Antonio, and  
12 Interstate Highway 35 between its intersection with Interstate 10  
13 in San Antonio and its intersection with United States Highway 190  
14 in Belton are designated as Heroes Highway.

15 (b) The department shall design and construct memorial  
16 markers indicating the highway number, the designation as Heroes  
17 Highway, and any other appropriate information.

18 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the  
19 highway and at appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
