## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to mandatory kindergarten attendance in public schools.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 25.085 (b) and (c), Education Code, are 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) Unless specifically exempted by Section 25.086, a child
- 7 who is at least five [six] years of age on the first day of August
- 8 [September] of the school year, or who is younger than five [six]
- 9 years of age and has previously been enrolled in <u>prekindergarten or</u>
- 10 kindergarten [first grade], and who has not yet reached the child's
- 11 18th birthday shall attend school.
- 12 (c) On enrollment in prekindergarten [or kindergarten], a
- 13 child shall attend school.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 29.009, Education Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 29.009. PUBLIC NOTICE CONCERNING PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS
- 17 FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES. Each school district shall develop
- 18 a system to notify the population in the district with children who
- 19 are at least three years of age but younger than <u>five</u> [six] years of
- 20 age and who are eligible for enrollment in a special education
- 21 program of the availability of the program.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately and applies
- 23 beginning with the 2003-2004 school year.
