- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 31, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 31.0015 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.0015. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN LEGAL IMMIGRANTS. The
- 8 department shall provide financial assistance in accordance with 8
- 9 U.S.C. Section 1612(b), as amended, to a person who:
- 10 (1) is a qualified alien, as defined by 8 U.S.C.
- 11 Sections 1641(b) and (c), as amended;
- 12 (2) meets the eligibility requirements of the
- financial assistance program;
- 14 (3) entered the United States on or after August 22,
- 15 1996; and

- 16 (4) has resided in the United States for a period of
- 17 five years after the date the person entered as a qualified alien.
- 18 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 19 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 20 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 21 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 22 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 23 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
