9	FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE. (a) The commission, in cooperation with
10	local workforce development boards, shall, for a recipient of
11	financial assistance participating in an employment program under
12	Chapter 31, Human Resources Code:
13	(1) identify unmet housing needs and assess whether
14	those needs are barriers to the recipient's full participation in
15	the workforce and attainment of financial stability and

- 17 (2) develop a service plan that takes into consideration the recipient's unmet housing needs.
- 19 <u>(b) The commission by rule shall develop and implement a</u>
 20 <u>program through which a recipient identified under Subsection (a)</u>
 21 <u>as having unmet housing needs is referred by the commission or local</u>
 22 <u>workforce development board to agencies and organizations</u>
 23 <u>providing housing programs and services and connected to other</u>
 24 housing resources. To provide those referrals and connections, the

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1	commission shall establish collaborative partnerships between:
2	(1) the commission;
3	(2) local workforce development boards;
4	(3) municipal, county, and regional housing

6	(4) sponsors of local housing programs and services.
7	(c) The commission shall ensure that commission and local
8	workforce development board staff members receive training
9	regarding the programs and services offered by agencies and
10	organizations with which the commission establishes partnerships
11	under Subsection (b) and other available housing resources.
12	SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2003, the Texas
13	Workforce Commission shall develop and implement the program
14	required by Section 302.0036(b), Labor Code, as added by this Act.
15	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
