- 9 recovery of real property held in peaceable and adverse possession
- 10 by another is not barred under this chapter at any time if the
- 11 person bringing the action:
- 12 (1) holds title to the real property; and
- 13 (2) has, from the time the person acquired title until
- 14 the time the action is filed, continuously paid the ad valorem taxes
- imposed on the property as they were due.
- SECTION 2. Section 16.026(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 17 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) A person must bring suit not later than 10 years after
- 19 the day the cause of action accrues to recover real property held in
- 20 peaceable and adverse possession by another who cultivates, uses,
- or enjoys the property, unless Section 16.0285 applies.
- 22 SECTION 3. Section 16.027, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 23 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 16.027. ADVERSE POSSESSION: 25-YEAR LIMITATIONS

- 1 PERIOD NOTWITHSTANDING DISABILITY. A person, regardless of whether
- 2 the person is or has been under a legal disability, must bring suit
- 3 not later than 25 years after the day the cause of action accrues to
- 4 recover real property held in peaceable and adverse possession by
- 5 another who cultivates, uses, or enjoys the property, unless
- 6 Section 16.0285 applies.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 8 applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after that
- 9 date. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date of
- 10 this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 11 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
