

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the application of the professional prosecutors law to
3 the district attorney for the 25th Judicial District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 46.002, Government Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 46.002. PROSECUTORS SUBJECT TO CHAPTER. This chapter
8 applies to all county prosecutors and to the following state
9 prosecutors:

21 Galveston, Gregg, Harrison, Hays, Hidalgo, Jasper, Jefferson,
22 Kaufman, Lubbock, McLennan, Madison, Navarro, Newton, Panola,
23 Polk, Randall, Rockwall, San Jacinto, Smith, Tarrant, Taylor,
24 Tyler, Upshur, Van Zandt, Victoria, Walker, Waller, Wichita, Wood,

1 and Yoakum; and

2 (3) the county attorneys performing the duties of
3 district attorneys in the counties of Andrews, Callahan, Cameron,
4 Castro, Colorado, Crosby, Ellis, Falls, Fannin, Freestone,
5 Grayson, Lamar, Lamb, Lampasas, Lee, Limestone, Marion, Milam,
6 Morris, Ochiltree, Orange, Rains, Red River, Robertson, Rusk,
7 Terry, Webb, and Willacy.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2005.
