- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 92.015 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 92.015. TENANT'S RIGHT TO SUMMON POLICE OR EMERGENCY
- 8 ASSISTANCE. (a) A landlord may not:
- 9 (1) prohibit or limit a residential tenant's right to
- 10 <u>summon police or other emergency assistance in response to domestic</u>
- 11 violence or other conduct; or
- 12 (2) impose monetary or other penalties on a tenant who
- 13 summons police or emergency assistance.
- 14 (b) The provisions of this section may not be waived by
- 15 contract.
- 16 SECTION 2. A provision in a lease entered into or renewed
- 17 before the effective date of this Act that does not comply with
- 18 Section 92.015, Property Code, as added by this Act, is governed by
- 19 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
