7	(1) expires on the 41st day after the date of issuance <u>;</u>

9	(2) [• If the person was driving a commercial motor
10	vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, a temporary driving permit
11	that authorizes the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle] is
12	not effective until 24 hours after the time of arrest.
13	SECTION 2. Subsection (e), Section 724.032, Transportation
14	Code, is amended to read as follows:
15	(e) A temporary driving permit issued under this section:
16	(1) expires on the 41st day after the date of issuance <u>;</u>
17	and
18	(2) [. If the person was driving a commercial motor
19	vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, a temporary driving permit
20	that authorizes the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle] is
21	not effective until 24 hours after the time of arrest.
22	SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a temporary driving
23	permit issued under Section 524.011 or 724.032, Transportation
24	Code, as amended by this Act, on or after the effective date of this

Act. A temporary driving permit issued before the effective date of
this Act is governed by the law as it existed when the permit was
issued, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
