S.B. No. 94

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the issuance of a temporary driving permit.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 524.011(f), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

(f) A temporary driving permit issued under this section:

(1) expires on the 41st day after the date of issuance; and

(2) [~~. If the person was driving a commercial motor vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, a temporary driving permit that authorizes the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle~~] is not effective until 24 hours after the time of arrest.

SECTION 2. Section 724.032(e), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

(e) A temporary driving permit issued under this section:

(1) expires on the 41st day after the date of issuance; and

(2) [~~. If the person was driving a commercial motor vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, a temporary driving permit that authorizes the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle~~] is not effective until 24 hours after the time of arrest.

SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a temporary driving permit issued under Section 524.011 or 724.032, Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, on or after the effective date of this

1 Act. A temporary driving permit issued before the effective date of
2 this Act is governed by the law as it existed when the permit was
3 issued, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
