1-9 relating to the issuance of a temporary driving permit.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (f), Section 524.011, Transportation  
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (f) A temporary driving permit issued under this section:

1-14 (1) expires on the 41st day after the date of issuance;  
1-15 and

1-16 (2) [~~— If the person was driving a commercial motor  
1-17 vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, a temporary driving permit  
1-18 that authorizes the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle~~] is  
1-19 not effective until 24 hours after the time of arrest.

1-20 SECTION 2. Subsection (e), Section 724.032, Transportation  
1-21 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 (e) A temporary driving permit issued under this section:

1-23 (1) expires on the 41st day after the date of issuance;  
1-24 and

1-25 (2) [~~— If the person was driving a commercial motor  
1-26 vehicle, as defined by Section 522.003, a temporary driving permit  
1-27 that authorizes the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle~~] is  
1-28 not effective until 24 hours after the time of arrest.

1-29 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a temporary driving  
1-30 permit issued under Section 524.011 or 724.032, Transportation  
1-31 Code, as amended by this Act, on or after the effective date of this  
1-32 Act. A temporary driving permit issued before the effective date of  
1-33 this Act is governed by the law as it existed when the permit was  
1-34 issued, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-35 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
