- 5 SECTION 1. Article 62.10(b), Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under this article is:

under Article 62.06; and

- 8 (1) a [state jail] felony of the third degree if:
- 9 (A) the actor is a person whose duty to register 10 expires under Article 62.12(b); or
- 11 (B) (2) a felony of the third degree if the 12 actor is a person whose duty to register expires under Article 62.12(a) and who is required to verify registration once each year
- 15 (2) [(3)] a felony of the second degree if the actor is 16 a person whose duty to register expires under Article 62.12(a) and 17 who is required to verify registration once each 90-day period 18 under Article 62.06.
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 20 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an 21 offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. For 22 purposes of this section, an offense is committed before the 23 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs 24 before that date.
