A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to carbon monoxide detectors in certain child-care 3 facilities and family homes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 42.060 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.060. CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS. (a) In this
- 8 section, "carbon monoxide detector" means a device that detects and
- 9 sounds an alarm to indicate the presence of a harmful level of
- 10 carbon monoxide gas.

- 11 (b) Each day-care center, group day-care home, and family
- 12 home must be equipped with carbon monoxide detectors in accordance
- 13 with department rules.
- 14 (c) The department by rule shall prescribe requirements
- 15 regarding the placement, installation, and number of carbon
- 16 monoxide detectors and maintenance procedures for those detectors.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 18 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) of this section, a
- 19 day-care center, group day-care home, or family home is not
- 20 required to be equipped with carbon monoxide detectors as required
- 21 by Section 42.060, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act,
- 22 before January 1, 2004.
