- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 46.15, Penal Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Sections 46.02 and 46.03 do not apply to:

- (1) peace officers, including commissioned peace 8 officers of another state that allows peace officers commissioned 9 10 in Texas to carry weapons in the other state, or special investigators under Article 2.122, Code of Criminal Procedure, and 11 neither section prohibits a peace officer or special investigator 12 13 from carrying a weapon in this state, including in an establishment in this state serving the public, regardless of whether the peace 14 officer or special investigator is engaged in the actual discharge 15 of the officer's or investigator's duties while carrying the 16 17 weapon;
- 18 (2) parole officers and neither section prohibits an 19 officer from carrying a weapon in this state if the officer is:
- 20 (A) engaged in the actual discharge of the 21 officer's duties while carrying the weapon; and
- (B) in compliance with policies and procedures adopted by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice regarding the possession of a weapon by an officer while on duty;

- 1 (3) community supervision and corrections department
- 2 officers appointed or employed under Section 76.004, Government
- 3 Code, and neither section prohibits an officer from carrying a
- 4 weapon in this state if the officer is:
- 5 (A) engaged in the actual discharge of the
- officer's duties while carrying the weapon; and
- 7 (B) authorized to carry a weapon under Section
- 8 76.0051, Government Code; or
- 9 (4) a judge or justice of the supreme court, the court
- 10 of criminal appeals, a court of appeals, a district court, a
- 11 criminal district court, a constitutional county court, a statutory
- 12 county court, a justice court, or a municipal court who is licensed
- 13 to carry a concealed handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411,
- 14 Government Code.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
