5	SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 38.171 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.171. FAILURE TO REPORT FELONY. (a) A person commits
8	an offense if the person:
9	(1) observes the commission of a felony under
10	circumstances in which a reasonable person would believe that an
11	offense had been committed in which serious bodily injury or death
12	may have resulted; and
13	(2) fails to immediately report the commission of the
14	offense to a peace officer or law enforcement agency under
15	<pre>circumstances in which:</pre>
16	(A) a reasonable person would believe that the
17	commission of the offense had not been reported; and
18	(B) the person could immediately report the
19	commission of the offense without placing himself or herself in
20	danger of suffering serious bodily injury or death.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
