S.B. No. 134

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 relating to the creation of an additional judicial district in
2 Parker County.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code, is
5 amended by adding Section 24.557 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 24.557. 413TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (PARKER COUNTY). The
7 413th Judicial District is composed of Parker County.

8 SECTION 2. Section 32.184(a), Government Code, is amended
9 to read as follows:

10 (a) The Commissioners Court of Parker County may budget for
11 and pay the judges [~~judge~~] of the 43rd and 413th judicial districts
12 [~~Judicial District~~] an annual salary not to exceed \$7,800 for
13 performing judicial and administrative services.

14 SECTION 3. Section 43.125, Government Code, is amended to
15 read as follows:

16 Sec. 43.125. 43RD JUDICIAL DISTRICT. The voters of the 43rd
17 Judicial District elect a district attorney who represents the
18 state in all cases before the 43rd and 413th district courts.

19 SECTION 4. Section 152.1901(b), Human Resources Code, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 (b) The [~~district court~~] judge of the 43rd Judicial District
22 is the chairman of the board.

23 SECTION 5. The 413th Judicial District is created and this
