- 8 (a) In this section, "promote" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 9 43.21.
- 10 (b) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 11 (1) photographs or by videotape or other electronic
- 12 means visually records another:
- 13 (A) (A) without the other person's consent;
- 14 and
- (B) $\left(\frac{(2)}{2}\right)$ with intent to arouse or gratify the
- 16 sexual desire of any person; or
- 17 (2) knowing the character and content of the
- 18 photograph or recording, promotes a photograph or visual recording
- 19 <u>described by Subdivision (1)</u>.
- 20 $\underline{\text{(c)}}$ [\(\frac{\(\beta\)}{\(\beta\)}\)] An offense under this section is a state jail
- 21 felony.
- 22 (d) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this
- 23 section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
- 24 may be prosecuted under this section or the other law.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 216, Local Government
- 2 Code, is amended by adding Section 216.903 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 216.903. REGULATION OF POLITICAL SIGNS BY
- 4 MUNICIPALITY. (a) In this section, "private real property" does
- 5 not include real property subject to an easement or other
- 6 encumbrance that allows a municipality to use the property for a
- 7 <u>public purpose.</u>
- 8 (b) A municipal charter provision or ordinance that
- 9 regulates signs may not, for a sign that contains primarily a
- 10 political message and that is located on private real property:
- 11 (1) prohibit the sign from being placed;
- 12 (2) require a permit or approval of the municipality
- or impose a fee for the sign to be placed; or
- 14 (3) restrict the size of the sign to a size smaller
- 15 than that permitted for other signs under the provision or
- 16 ordinance.
- 17 (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a sign, including a
- 18 billboard, that contains primarily a political message on a
- 19 temporary basis and that is generally available for rent or
- 20 purchase to carry commercial advertising or other messages that are
- 21 not primarily political.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
