- SECTION 7. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- (b) A state agency that is subject to this Act shall develop

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- 1 written and other materials that contain the information required
- 2 by this Act not later than January 1, 2004. The state agencies that
- 3 are subject to this Act shall:
- 4 (1) cooperate in developing the materials; and
- 5 (2) ensure, to the extent possible, that the same
- 6 information is contained in the materials used by each agency.
