- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 162, Family Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 162.023 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 162.023. ADOPTION ORDER FROM FOREIGN COUNTRY.
- 8 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, an adoption order
- 9 rendered to a resident of this state that is made by a foreign
- 10 country shall be accorded full faith and credit by the courts of
- 11 this state and enforced as if the order were rendered by a court in
- this state unless the adoption law or process of the foreign country
- violates the fundamental principles of human rights or the laws or
- 14 public policy of this state.
- (b) A person who adopts a child in a foreign country may
- 16 register the order in this state. A petition for registration of a
- foreign adoption order may be combined with a petition for a name
- 18 change. If the court finds that the foreign adoption order meets
- 19 the requirements of Subsection (a), the court shall order the state
- 20 <u>registrar to:</u>
- 21 (1) register the order under Chapter 192, Health and
- 22 Safety Code; and
- 23 (2) file a certificate of birth for the child under
- 24 Section 192.006, Health and Safety Code.
