A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the application of the open meetings law and the public
3	information law to meetings and information regarding certain
4	response plans of a municipal hospital or hospital district.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 551.090 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 551.090. CERTAIN DELIBERATIONS OF GOVERNING BOARD OF
9	MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL OR HOSPITAL DISTRICT. This chapter does not
10	require the governing board of a municipal hospital or a hospital
11	district created under general or special law to conduct an open
12	meeting to deliberate the details, or specific occasions for
13	implementation, of a plan for responding to a natural,
14	technological, or man-made hazard or to an act of terrorism.
15	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
16	amended by adding Section 552.145 to read as follows:
17	Sec. 552.145. EXCEPTION: CERTAIN RESPONSE PLANS OF
18	MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL OR HOSPITAL DISTRICT. Information is excepted
19	from the requirements of Section 552.021 if:
20	(1) the information relates to a plan of a municipal
21	hospital or a hospital district for responding to a natural,
22	technological, or man-made hazard or to an act of terrorism; and
23	(2) the municipal hospital or hospital district
24	believes that disclosure of the information would interfere with

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- 1 the implementation of that response plan by the municipal hospital
- 2 <u>or hospital district.</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
