20	(b) The commissioner by rule shall adopt guidelines a board
21	of trustees must use in making a determination of whether a sale or
22	lease of school district real property would result in adequate
23	property remaining for students' recreational purposes. In
24	adopting those guidelines, the commissioner shall provide for

1	elementary schools to have adequate property remaining for recess,
2	team activities, and any other activity determined by the
3	commissioner and for secondary schools to have adequate property
4	remaining for team sports and any other activity determined by the
5	commissioner.
6	SECTION 3. Section 11.1542, Education Code, as added by
7	this Act, applies only to sale or lease of school district property
8	under a contract entered into on or after September 1, 2003. Sale
9	or lease of school district property under a contract entered into
10	before September 1, 2003, is governed by the law in effect on the
11	date the contract was entered into, and that law is continued in
12	effect for that purpose.
13	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
