- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 49, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 49.002 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 49.002. EDUCATION FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AND
- 7 ATTORNEYS. (a) The department shall develop a program to educate
- 8 health care providers and attorneys in this state regarding
- 9 anatomical gifts.
- 10 (b) The department through the program shall encourage
- 11 attorneys to provide organ donation information to clients seeking
- 12 legal advice for end-of-life decisions.
- 13 (c) The department shall encourage medical schools and
- 14 nursing schools in this state to include mandatory organ donation
- 15 education in the schools' curriculums.
- 16 (d) The department shall encourage medical schools in this
- 17 state to require a physician in a neurology or neurosurgery
- 18 residency program to complete an advanced course in organ donation
- 19 <u>education</u>.
- (e) The department shall implement the program only to the
- 21 extent that:
- (1) funds are available from Section 521.421(g) or
- 23 521.422(c), Transportation Code;
- 24 (2) money or in-kind donations are donated to the

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- 1 department for the purpose of implementing the program; or
- 2 (3) the legislature specifically appropriates money
- 3 from another source for the purpose of implementing the program.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
