- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 36, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 36.215 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 36.215. RECORDING OF JURY DELIBERATIONS. A person may
- 8 not use any device to produce or make an audio, visual, or
- 9 audio-visual broadcast, recording, or photograph of a jury while
- 10 the jury is deliberating.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subtitle B, Title 2, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 12 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 24 to read as follows:
- 13 CHAPTER 24. RECORDING OF JURY DELIBERATIONS
- Sec. 24.001. RECORDING PROHIBITED. A person may not use any
- 15 device to produce or make an audio, visual, or audio-visual
- 16 broadcast, recording, or photograph of a jury while the jury is
- 17 deliberating.
- SECTION 3. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 19 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a
- 20 trial commenced on or after September 1, 2003. A trial commenced
- 21 before September 1, 2003, is covered by the law in effect when the
- trial commenced, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 23 purpose.
