5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 552.141 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.141. CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION IN
8	APPLICATION FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE. (a) Information that is
9	maintained by a county clerk and that is on an application for a
10	marriage license, including information in an application on behalf
11	of an absent applicant and the affidavit of an absent applicant, or
12	is on a document submitted with an application for a marriage
13	license is confidential and may not be disclosed by the county clerk
14	to the public under this chapter if the individual to whom the
15	<pre>information relates:</pre>
16	(1) chooses to restrict public access to the
17	information; and
18	(2) notifies the county clerk of the individual's
19	choice on a form to be provided by the county clerk at the time the
20	county clerk furnishes the application for the marriage license.
21	(b) A choice made under Subsection (a) remains valid until

rescinded in writing by the individual.

- 5 SECTION 2. Section 552.141, Government Code, as added by
- 6 this Act, applies only to an application for a marriage license that
- 7 is filed on or after September 1, 2003.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
