- 4 SECTION 1. Section 341.011, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 341.011. NUISANCE. Each of the following is a public
- 7 health nuisance:
- 8 (1) a condition or place that is a breeding place for
- 9 flies and that is in a populous area;
- 10 (2) spoiled or diseased meats intended for human
- 11 consumption;
- 12 (3) a restaurant, food market, bakery, other place of
- 13 business, or vehicle in which food is prepared, packed, stored,
- 14 transported, sold, or served to the public and that is not
- 15 constantly maintained in a sanitary condition;
- 16 (4) a place, condition, or building controlled or
- 17 operated by a state or local government agency that is not
- 18 maintained in a sanitary condition;
- 19 (5) sewage, human excreta, wastewater, garbage, or
- 20 other organic wastes deposited, stored, discharged, or exposed in
- 21 such a way as to be a potential instrument or medium in disease
- transmission to a person or between persons;
- 23 (6) a vehicle or container that is used to transport
- 24 garbage, human excreta, or other organic material and that is

- 1 defective and allows leakage or spilling of contents;
- 2 (7) a collection of water in which mosquitoes are
- 3 breeding in the limits of a municipality or a collection of water
- 4 that is a breeding area for Culex quinquefasciatus mosquitoes that
- 5 can transmit diseases regardless of the collection's location other
- 6 than a location or property where activities meeting the definition
- of Section 11.002(12)(A), Water Code, occur;
- 8 (8) a condition that may be proven to injuriously
- 9 affect the public health and that may directly or indirectly result
- 10 from the operations of a bone boiling or fat rendering plant, tallow
- or soap works, or other similar establishment;
- 12 (9) a place or condition harboring rats in a populous
- 13 area;
- 14 (10) the presence of ectoparasites, including
- 15 bedbugs, lice, and mites, suspected to be disease carriers in a
- 16 place in which sleeping accommodations are offered to the public;
- 17 (11) the maintenance of an open surface privy or an
- overflowing septic tank so that the contents may be accessible to
- 19 flies; and
- 20 (12) an object, place, or condition that is a possible
- 21 and probable medium of disease transmission to or between humans.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
