## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 152.014(a), Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) In each county there is a salary grievance committee
- 9 composed of the county judge and:
- 10 (1) the sheriff, county tax assessor-collector,
- 11 county treasurer, county clerk, district clerk, county attorney or
- 12 criminal district attorney, and the number of public members
- 13 necessary to provide nine voting members; or
- 14 (2) nine public members, if the commissioners court
- 15 votes [in January each year] to have nine public members.
- SECTION 2. Sections 152.015(a) and (c), Local Government
- 17 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The public members of the salary grievance committee
- 19 shall be selected at a meeting of the court not later than the 15th
- 20 day after the date a request for a hearing is received under Section
- 21 <u>152.016(a)</u> [in January each year]. If a request for a public hearing
- is not received, the commissioners court is not required to select
- 23 public members.
- (c) A public member serves until the end of the fiscal year

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- 1 <u>in which the public member</u> [a successor] is appointed [the
- 2 <u>following January</u>].
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 152.016, Local Government Code, is
- 4 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (b) The committee shall hold a public hearing <u>not later than</u>
- 7 the later of the 10th day [within 10 days] after:
  - (1) the date the request is received; or
- 9 (2) the date the commissioners court selects the
- 10 public members of the committee.
- 11 (b-1) The chairman shall announce the time and place of the
- 12 hearing.

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- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004, and
- 14 applies only to the salary or expense of an elected county or
- 15 precinct officer for a county fiscal year that begins on or after
- 16 that date.
