2	relating to vehicles passing certain stationary emergency vehicles
3	on a highway.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.157 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.157. PASSING AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLE. On
8	approaching a stationary authorized emergency vehicle using visual
9	signals that meet the requirements of Sections 547.305 and 547.702,
10	an operator, unless otherwise directed by a police officer, shall:
11	(1) vacate the lane closest to the emergency vehicle
12	when driving on a highway with two or more lanes traveling in the
13	direction of the emergency vehicle; or
14	(2) slow to a speed not to exceed:
15	(A) 20 miles per hour less than the posted speed
16	limit when the posted speed limit is 25 miles per hour or more; or
17	(B) five miles per hour when the posted speed
18	limit is less than 25 miles per hour.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
