8	Sec. 466.451. MULTISTATE AGREEMENT AUTHORIZED. The
9	commission shall enter into a written agreement with the
10	appropriate officials of one or more other states or take other
11	appropriate action to participate in the operation of one or more
12	ongoing multistate lottery games.
13	Sec. 466.452. REVENUE FROM MULTISTATE LOTTERY. (a) Except
14	as provided by this section, revenue received from the sale of
15	tickets in this state for a multistate lottery game is subject to
16	Subchapter H.
17	(b) The commission may:
18	(1) deposit a portion of the revenue received from the
19	sale of multistate lottery game tickets in this state into a fund
20	shared with other parties to an agreement under this subchapter for
21	the payment of prizes awarded in multistate lottery games in which
22	the commission participates; and
23	(2) retain the portion of revenue deposited in the

- 3 Sec. 466.453. PAYMENT OF COSTS AUTHORIZED. The commission
- 4 may share in the payment of costs associated with participating in
- 5 <u>multistate lottery games.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
