- 2 relating to a receipt or other document issued for payment by credit
- 3 or debit card; providing a civil penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 35, Business & Commerce
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 35.58 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 35.58. BUSINESS RECEIPT CONTAINING CREDIT CARD OR
- 8 DEBIT CARD INFORMATION. (a) This section does not apply to a
- 9 transaction in which the sole means of recording a person's credit
- 10 card or debit card account number on a receipt or other document
- 11 evidencing the transaction is by handwriting or by an imprint or
- 12 copy of the credit card or debit card.
- (b) A person that accepts a credit card or debit card for the
- 14 transaction of business may not print more than the last four digits
- of the credit card or debit card account number or the month and
- 16 year of the credit card's or debit card's expiration date on a
- 17 receipt or other document that evidences the transaction and that
- is provided to a cardholder.
- (c) A person who provides, leases, or sells a cash register
- 20 or other machine used to print receipts or other documents
- 21 evidencing credit card or debit card transactions shall provide
- 22 notice of the requirements of this section to the recipient,
- 23 <u>lessee</u>, or buyer, as applicable, of the machine.
- 24 (d) A court may not certify an action brought under this

- 1 <u>section as a class action.</u>
- 2 (e) A person who violates Subsection (b) is liable to the 3 state for a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$500 for each
- 4 calendar month during which a violation occurs. The civil penalty
- 5 may not be imposed for more than one violation that occurs in a
- 6 month. The attorney general or the prosecuting attorney in the
- 7 county in which the violation occurs may bring suit to recover the
- 8 civil penalty imposed under this section.
- 9 <u>(f)</u> The attorney general may bring an action in the name of
- 10 the state to restrain or enjoin a person from violating Subsection
- 11 (b).
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 13 (b) With respect to a cash register or other machine that is
- 14 initially installed and in operation after August 31, 2003, this
- 15 Act applies only to a receipt or other document evidencing a credit
- 16 card or debit card transaction that is electronically printed by
- the cash register or other machine after August 31, 2004.
- 18 (c) With respect to a cash register or other machine that is
- in operation before September 1, 2003, this Act applies only to a
- 20 sales receipt or other document evidencing a credit card or debit
- 21 card transaction that is electronically printed by the cash
- register or other machine after December 31, 2005.
