- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 42.002, Parks and
- 5 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 42.002. RESIDENT LICENSE REQUIRED; EXEMPTION.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 42.002, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 8 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (a) Except as provided by Subsections [Subsection] (b) and
- 11 (c) of this section, no resident may hunt any bird or animal in this
- 12 state without having acquired a hunting license.
- 13 (c) A resident landowner or the landowner's agent or lessee
- 14 may take feral hogs causing depredation on the resident landowner's
- 15 land without having acquired a hunting license.
- 16 SECTION 3. Section 42.005, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (f) to

- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (f), no $[N_{\Theta}]$
- 20 nonresident may hunt any bird or animal in this state without first
- 21 having acquired a general nonresident hunting license, a

- 4 SECTION 4. Subchapter H, Chapter 43, Parks and Wildlife
- 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 43.158 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 43.158. LANDOWNER PERMIT EXEMPTION. Nothing in this
- 7 subchapter prevents a landowner or the landowner's agent or lessee
- 8 from taking depredating feral hogs on the landowner's land without
- 9 having acquired a permit under this subchapter.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
