2	relating to allowing youth camps to correct violations during
3	inspections by the Texas Department of Health.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 141.007, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows:
7	(d) An employee or agent of the department who enters a
8	youth camp to investigate and inspect conditions shall:
9	(1) notify the person in charge of the camp of any
10	violations as they are discovered; and
11	(2) allow the camp to correct the violations while the
12	investigation and inspection is occurring.
13	(e) An employee or agent of the department performing ar
14	investigation and inspection under this section may not report a
15	violation that is corrected during the investigation and
16	inspection.

- 17 <u>(f) A penalty may not be imposed on a youth camp for a</u>
- 18 violation that is corrected during an investigation and inspection
- 19 <u>under this section</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. Subsections (d), (e), and (f), Section 141.007,
- 21 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act apply only to an
- investigation and inspection of a youth camp that occurs on or after
- 23 the effective date of this Act. An investigation and inspection
- that occurred before the effective date of this Act is governed by

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- 1 the law in effect on the date the investigation and inspection
- 2 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
