- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 662.005, Government
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and
- 9 notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, a state employee
- 10 who is a peace officer commissioned by the Department of Public
- 11 Safety or who is employed by the Department of Public Safety to
- 12 perform communications or dispatch services related to traffic law
- 13 <u>enforcement</u> and who is required to work on a national or state
- 14 holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is entitled to
- 15 compensatory time off at the rate of one hour for each hour worked
- 16 on the holiday.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
