## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to compensatory time off for certain communications
- 3 service employees of the Department of Public Safety.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 662.005(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Section 662.010, and
- 8 notwithstanding Section 659.015 or another law, a state employee
- 9 who is a peace officer commissioned by the Department of Public
- 10 Safety or who is employed by the Department of Public Safety to
- 11 perform communications or dispatch services related to traffic law
- 12 <u>enforcement</u> and who is required to work on a national or state
- 13 holiday that falls on a Saturday or Sunday is entitled to
- 14 compensatory time off at the rate of one hour for each hour worked
- 15 on the holiday.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
